

2013 ATG Coupe Mondiale Competition Categories



Welcome to the 66th Coupe Mondiale in Victoria, BC (Canada) to be held from the 17 - 25 August, 2013. The Accordionists and Teachers Guild, International (ATG) will offer the appropriate qualifications to interested candidates in the categories listed below. The ATG qualifications will be held via candidates submitting Videos of their competition program to the ATG for evaluation. Videos must be received by May 1st, 2013. For this competition, respective age limits apply to the contestant's age as of this year, 2013. Up to 32 years means born 1981 or later and up to 18 years means born 1995 or later.

Maximum 7 minutes playing time.</p> <p>Round 2 Own Choice Program – at least 2 pieces of different styles and moods. Maximum 7 minutes playing time.</p>
<p>JUNIOR COUPE MONDIALE (2 Rounds) up to 18 years of age</p> <p style="text-align: right;">1st Prize - \$300</p> <p>Round 1 Any Baroque work, 2 own choice pieces – 1 slow, lyrical style – 2nd of technical virtuosic style. Minimum of 2 different composers and Min. 10 minutes, max. 15 minutes. Individual movements may be used.</p> <p>Round 2 2 pieces of choice – 1 must be original – individual movements of works are acceptable however only 1 movement of that work may be used.</p>	<p>INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION FOR ENSEMBLE MUSIC (1 Round) up to 32 years of age</p> <p style="text-align: right;">1st Prize - \$300</p> <p>Own Choice Program 2-5 musicians – minimum 1 accordion. No electronics (except Bass instrument may be amplified if necessary). Own Choice Program of concert music – at least 2 contrasting pieces. Minimum 15 minutes, maximum 20 minutes.</p>
	<p>INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION FOR DIGITAL ACCORDION (1 Round) up to 32 years of age</p> <p style="text-align: right;">1st Prize - \$300</p> <p>Own Choice Show Entertainment Program with a maximum of 15 minutes playing time.</p>

Membership/Entry requirements: Contestants who are students of an ATG member must enter through their teacher. If the instructor is not affiliated with ATG, the ATG membership fee of \$45.00 should be submitted along with the entry. Independent accordionists must also be an ATG member to enter, and should submit their ATG membership fee of \$45.00 along with the entry, entitling the contestant to ATG membership benefits for one year.

Entry Fee: USD \$60.00 per category
