International Classical Accordion Competition

13-15 April 2012

XI th Music Competition organized by Rotary Club Gent

Rotary Club Gent (Belgium) and GIFT vzw organize every year a competition to support young professional musicians and to promote some undervalued instruments. As the accordion is a rising instrument in Belgium, the competition 2012 is dedicated to it, thus to help persuade concert organizers to enlist this wonderful instrument !

Regulations

- The competition for solo accordionists is held in Gent from April 13th to April 15th 2012. The first round takes place on Friday April 13th 2012. The finale round takes place on Saturday April 14th 2012. The presentation and concert of the prize winners takes place on Sunday April 15th 2012. The location is at: Concert Hall of the Royal Conservatory, Hoogpoort 64, Gent. The competition is open to the public.
- 2. Accordionists of all nationalities and born after April 15th 1984 can participate.
- 3. The number of participants to the first round is limited to 20. In case of a larger number of entries, a pre-selection will be held on base of a video/dvd recording , placed on YouTube *Information follows after closing date entries*.
- 4. The number of participants to the final round is maximum 6.
- All winners must be present in person at the Awards Ceremony and Laureates Concert on Sunday April 15th 2012 at 8 p.m. In case of non appearance, the prize winner will be disqualified and the complete prize withdrawn.

The jury has the right not to grant one of the prizes.

- 6. The members of the jury, all excellent musicians, will be presented to the candidates at the start of the competition. No member of the jury is allowed to evaluate one of its own students.
- 7. The artistic decisions of the jury are irrevocable; all administrative problems are solved by the legal adviser of Rotary Club Gent.

8. The program requires

- <u>First round</u> (about 15 to maximum 20 min. in duration):
 - a) a Prelude and Fugue from the Well Tempered Clavichord (J.S. Bach)
 - b) a program chosen by the competitor including at least one piece from the original accordion repertoire. A composition by a Belgian composer will be appreciated.
- <u>Final round</u> (minimum 25 to maximum 30 min. in duration):
 - a) a Sonata by Domenico Scarlatti
 - b) a piece inspired by folklore (transcriptions are allowed)
 - c) a representative piece from the original 20th / 21th century repertoire with a virtuosic character (such as work by Aho, Berio, Feld, Gubaidulina, Lindberg etc.)
 - d) a piece of lyrical style (such as work by Angelis, Semionov, Solotarev etc.)
 - P.S. In this program, a candidate can "ad libitum" incorporate an ensemble piece.

9. Prizes

- 1st Prize: 2.000 EUR
- 2nd Prize: 1.000 EUR
- 3th Prize: 500 EUR
- Special Concert Prize "Prize Municipality of Aalter" (worth 500 Euro) will be
 - attributed to the *best classified Belgian participant*, obtaining at least 80 % of the points. This concert will be organized in Aalter on Sunday the 5th of May 2013 within the "Kasteelconcerten van Poeke" and asks <u>for a program partly solo and partly in chamber music</u>.
- 10. The organizers have the right to make, produce and distribute audio and video recordings of the performances; contestants will not be paid for that.
- 11. Changes of programs are only possible till April 1st 2012.
- 12. Clean copies of all scores of the chosen programs in A4-format must be sent to the secretary before April 1st 2012.

13. Registration fee

The amount of **50 EUR** must be paid *before February* 15th 2012 on the account of : GIFT vzw, Meerkensdreef 3, B-9880 Aalter; on account number IBAN: BE 50 0682 2968 5418 - BIC/SWIFT: GKCCBEBB with reference: Accordion Contest + name candidate. The registration is accepted only after the fee is received. In case of cancellation or non-participation, the registration fee will not be refunded.

- a copy of the obtained certificate, or if such is unavailable, an attestation of the candidate's level by the actual or a former teacher ;

- the programs presented at both rounds.
