For the 1st place the competitior or Ensemble must achieve at least 95 points, for the 2nd place at least 90 points, and for the 3rd place at least 85 points.

REGULATIONS

The meeting will be public in Beltinci. The exact schedule of the appearances will be published 14 days before the start of the meeting. The registered candidates will receive it by post (email).

Each registered candidate must report at the information office at least one hour before the competition starts in the category that he is registered for.

He also must prepare two copies of music before the competition programme (not necessary for the competitors in categories »Diatonic accordion« and »The music of Slavko and Vilko Avsenik«). If these conditions are not meet, the jury can exclude the competitor.

The results will be published two hours after the conclusion of the performances in each category at the latest.

The granting of the awards will be at the final concert of the 10th Accordionist's meeting, which will take place from 9th till 11th May 2014 in Beltinci.

At the final concert each prizeman has to carry out a part of the programme, defined by the jury.

The members of the jury will be acknowledged European musicians and successful teachers. The evaluation by the jury is ultimate.

Besides the competition, interesting concerts, the presentation of music material and instruments will take place as well.

Each active participants has free access to all events regarding the 10th international Accordionist's meeting 2013 in Beltinci.
