



The 5th Krakow Accordion Festival will consist of concerts and accompanying events: workshops and lectures, the Film Competition for accordion music and an exhibition of visual communication design for the Association of Polish Accordionists, created in cooperation with the Department of Industrial Forms of the Academy of Fine Arts in Krakow, and a reading of the poetry of St. John Paul II.

The concerts of the 5th Krakow Accordion Festival will be divided into 9 musical categories: Contemporary Music - Premieres, Early Music, Chamber Music, Film Music, World Music, Jazz Music, Vocal-Accordion Music, Improvised Music - Intermedia, Instrumental Theater. 




