

"LÀSZLÒ SPEZZAFERRI" International Music Competition

REGULATION

Art. 1: THE EVENT

The IV International Music Prize "Laszlo Spezzaferri" aims to promote and encourage youth musical activity and is organized by the Cultural Talent Music School and the patronage of the Councilorship for Youth Policies of the Municipality of Verona In the 2022 edition the Prize will take place ONLINE thanks to the sending of videos by the registered participants.

Art. 2: PARTICIPANTS

The

- soloists of all instruments without age limits (piano, harpsichord, organ, harp, accordion, guitar , strings, winds, brass, percussion, opera singing)

- chamber music groups up to 7 members

- to orchestral and choral ensembles

Divided

into the categories referred to in Article 3.

The test program of each category is free to choose.

Art. 3: CATEGORIES

SOLOISTS

(piano, harpsichord, organ, harp, accordion, strings, winds, brass, guitar, opera singing, percussion)

THE COMPETITOR'S AGE IS CALCULATED AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION (MAY 31, 2022)

"Junior": solo musicians up to 9 years of age at the time of the competition start date.

Maximum duration of the test: 7 minutes.

Cat. A: solo musicians up to 12 years at the time of the competition start date.

Maximum duration of the test: 10 minutes.

Cat. B: solo musicians aged 13 to 16 at the time of the competition start date.

Maximum duration of the test: 13 minutes.

Cat. C: solo musicians aged 17 to 20 at the time of the competition start date.

Maximum duration of the test: 15 minutes.

Cat. D: solo musicians aged 21 and over without age limits.

Maximum duration of the test: 20 minutes.

CHAMBER MUSIC

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Maximum duration of the test: 15 minutes.

Cat. D: solo musicians aged 21 and over without age limits.

Maximum duration of the test: 20 minutes.

CHAMBER MUSIC

Cat. E: Chamber music groups made up of a maximum of 7 elements (with an average age of the members of maximum 14 years).

Maximum duration of the test: 8 minutes

Cat. F: Chamber music groups made up of a maximum of 7 members (with an average age of the members of maximum 20 years).

Maximum duration of the test: 12 minutes

ENSEMBLE

Cat. G: Orchestral and / or choral ensembles composed of at least 8 elements (with an average age of the members of maximum 14 years)
Maximum duration of the test: 10 minutes

Cat. H: Orchestral and / or choral ensembles composed of at least 8 elements (with an average age of the members of maximum 20 years)
Maximum duration of the test: 15 minutes

Art . 4: JURY

The Jury, made up of well-known musicians, will receive the material sent by the candidates and will express their vote in hundredths, which will be unquestionable and unappealable.

The members of the Jury who have in place or who have had teaching relationships with one or more competitors in the two previous years are required to refrain from voting on the test of the same competitors. This abstention must be explicitly referred to in the minutes. Upon taking office, each member of the Jury must issue a declaration on their personal situation towards the competitors in relation to the above.

Therefore it is mandatory to indicate the name of their teachers in the registration form.

In each category there will be at least one juror for each of the following instruments presented by the participants: piano / harpsichord / organ / harp / accordion / percussion, strings, wind / brass, guitar and opera singing.

Art. 5: PRIZES The following prizes will be awarded
for First prize (with a score from 98/100 to 100/100): cup and diploma
First prize (with a score from 95/100 to 97/100): medal and diploma
Second prize (with a score from 90/100 to 94/100): medal and diploma
Third prize (with a score from 85/100 to 89/100): medal and diploma

All other competitors will be awarded a certificate of participation.
ALL DIPLOMAS WILL BE SENT VIA EMAIL. MEDALS AND CUPS WILL BE SHIPPED
WITHIN THE COUNTRIES OF THE EU + SWITZERLAND. PARTICIPANTS RESIDING IN A
NON-EU COUNTRY, WILL BE ABLE TO INDICATE A SHIPPING ADDRESS WITHIN THE EU
+ SWITZERLAND OR CHOOSE TO RECEIVE THE PRIZE IN ELECTRONIC FORMAT.

discretion of the Commission, to perform live during the Award Concert
organized in the following period.

Art. 6: AWARDS

winners of the SCHOLARSHIPS will be announced through an AWARDS CEREMONY
IN STREAMING.

All FIRST ABSOLUTE PRIZES, FIRST PRIZES, SECOND PRIZES, THIRD PRIZES will
be shipped.

RULES

Art. 1: COMPETITION

The IV International Music Prize "Laszlo Spezzaferri" is organized in order to promote the musical culture and draw young people to music study and development, and is organized by Talent Music School Musical Association under the Patronage of Municipality of Verona. The 2022 edition will take place ONLINE, through sending video by all the applicants.

2: PARTICIPANTS

The IV International Music Prize of Verona "Laszlo Spezzaferri" Online edition is opened to participant from all the countries as follows:

- Solo musicians of any instruments without age limit (piano, organ, harpsicord, harp, accordion, guitar, strings , winds, brass, percussion and voice)
- Chamber music groups until 7 musicians
- Orchestral ensembles and Choirs

divided into categories referred to Art. 3.
The program is a free choice repertoire.

Art. 3: CATEGORIES

SOLOISTS
(piano, harpsicord, organ, harp, accordion, strings, winds, brass, guitar, voice, percussions)

AGE OF THE APPLICANTS IS CONSIDERED AT THE MOMENT OF APPLICATION (MAY 31ST, 2022)

Cat. "Junior": opened to solo musicians until 9 years old at the moment of the competition.

Max. Performance duration: 7 minutes

Cat. A - opened to solo musicians until 12 years old at the moment of the competition.

Max. Performance duration: 10 minutes

Cat. B - opened to solo musicians from 13 to 16 years old at the moment of the competition.

Max. Performance duration: 13 minutes

Cat. C - opened to solo musicians from 17 to 20 years old at the moment of the competition.

Max. Performance duration: 15 minutes

Cat. D - opened to solo musicians from 21 years old without age limit.

Max. Performance duration: 20 minutes

CHAMBER MUSIC

Cat. E - opened to chamber music ensembles from 2 to 7 musicians, with a maximum average age limit of 14 years old

Max. Performance duration: 8 minutes

Cat. F - opened to chamber music ensembles from 2 to 7 musicians, with a maximum average age limit of 20 years old

Max. performance duration: 12 minutes

ENSEMBLE Cat . G - opened to Ensemble and Choirs with a minimum of 8 components, with a maximum average age limit of 14 years old max. performance duration: 10 minutes Cat. H - opened to Ensemble and Choirs with a minimum of 8 components, with a maximum average age limit of 20 years old Max. performance duration: 15 minutes

AGE OF THE APPLICANTS IS CONSIDERED AT THE MOMENT OF APPLICATION (MAY 31ST, 2022)

Art. 4: JURY

The judges, excellent reputation musicians / masters, will receive all the sent musical material and will express a mark out of 100. Awards and scholarship cannot be assigned in case the jury consider the competitors non-deserving.

Actions and decisions of the judges are unquestionable and irrevocable.

Judges that tutored / taught one or more of the competitors during the previous two years are requested to abstain from participating to dealings / votes related to the nominated competitors performances; the occurrence should be clearly reported in the competition memorandum. At assignment, each judge will issue a declaration related to the mentioned teaching / tutorial activity with the competitors.

In view of what above reported, the competitors are compelled to report in the application form the name of their teachers.

Each category will be judged by almost one juror from each group of instruments with applicants: piano / harpsicord / organ / harp / accordion / percussions, strings, winds / brass, guitar and voice.

Art. 5: AWARDS

All these prizes will be awarded for each category:

First Absolute prize (with a mark from 98/100 to 100/100):
diploma & cup

First Prize (with a mark from 95/100 to 97/100): diploma & gold medal

Second Prize (with a mark from 90/100 to 94/100): diploma & silver medal

Third Prize (with a mark from 85/100 to 89/100): diploma & bronze medal

All the other contestants will received a Participation Certificate.

ALL THE DIPLOMAS WILL BE EMAILED TO THE WINNERS. THE CUPS AND MEDALS WILL BE MAILED TO UE COUNTRIES + SWITZERLAND. PARTICIPANTS LIVING OUTSIDE UE CAN PROVIDE AN ADDRESS INTO UE + SWITZERLAND OR CHOOSE TO RECEIVE TELEMATIC PRIZES.
