Horace Lazzari

Horace Lazzari, born in Ontario, Canada, lived most of his life in Vancouver, British Columbia. He has played the accordion since the age of two, and at nine years of age was known as Canada's boy wonder on the instrument. During the war he toured with the famed CANADIAN ARMY SHOW and is considered one of Canada's finest accordionists.

Recently he moved to the United States and now makes his home in Walla Walla, Washington, where he is engaged in teaching and radio work.

His virtuosity and interpretations of the classics have helped to bring about a new conception of the accordion as a concert instrument.
